CLIMATE

The region is popular for its comfortable year round subtropical climate with on average 250 days of sunshine each year. The average daily sunshine ranges from 6.5 hours during July (winter) increasing to 8.7 hours during December (summer). Dress is mostly informal and casual, with lightweight clothing suitable most of the year. Temperatures range from Summer (December – February) 20 – 30°C , water temp 26°C and Winter (June-August) 5 – 20°C, water temp 21°C.

DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

Daylight Saving Time is the process of putting clocks forward one (1) hour during summer to extend the hours of daylight available at the end of the normal working day. Residents of New South Wales generally turn their clocks forward at the end of October to the beginning of April. However, residents of Queensland have not adopted this practice. Living on the border often causes confusion and disruption as many people work and live in separate time zones.

SAFETY

- **SNAKE SAFETY**

The most common snake in the local area is the Eastern Brown Snake - the second most deadly in the world. Snakes are deaf but feel vibrations. If you encounter a snake DON'T PANIC, it is unlikely to attack or bite unless provoked. If you move towards it or attempt to pick it up, you may provoke an attack. However, standing still or slowly moving away gives the snake a chance to escape harmlessly. In the event of a snake bite dial 000 for emergency assistance.

- **SUN SAFETY**

The sun in Australia is intense and caution should be taken when spending long periods of time outdoors. Any sun injury enough to cause tanning will increase your risk of skin cancer and premature aging of the skin. Things you can do to minimise your chances of being over exposed to the sun include:

- Wear sunglasses with UV protection
- Wear a hat and a long sleeved shirt
- Take extra precautions between 10am and 3pm when the sun's rays are most damaging
- Apply sun-screen with sun protection factor (SPF) of 15+ or more
- Reapply sunscreen every few hours, or more frequently if you are swimming, sweating or towelling off.

- **SURF SAFELY**

Salt Beach is patrolled 365 days per year to ensure residents and visitors safely enjoy the 1.2 kilometres of ocean front at Salt Village. You are strongly encouraged to always swim between the flags and only when lifeguards are on duty. A safe area to swim is between two red and yellow flags, whereas a red flag means do not enter the water and a yellow flag means swim with caution.
